

Changes from the National Truck Driving Championship Committee –

1. **New Rule** - Rule number 7 on the 2023 TR 1 – 2 – As of January 1, 2023, a competing driver may not serve as a member of any State Trucking Association Truck Driving Championships Committee. Drivers may still serve as volunteers at TDC where they are not competing, but to maintain the integrity of the event we ask that all competing drivers be removed from committee positions. If you have any question regarding this rule change, please reach out.
2. We no longer require a CDL to be included in NTDC registration, only an MVR is required.

Eligibility Reminders –

1. Owner-Operators are not eligible to compete in the TDC program unless they are contracted to a single company
2. Those who driver professionally and also serve as driver trainers are required to spend 60% of their time serving as a professional driver (behind the wheel) and must perform the regular duties of a professional truck driver for a minimum of 1200 hours annually

Other Items -

1. Facts for Drivers and the rulebook will be available soon. We are closing out final details now. I'll let you know as soon as they are available.
2. NTDC / NSVDC is scheduled for August 16 – 19, 2023 in Columbus, OH.
3. You will not receive NTDC packets for your champions this year. Once your champions are registered with the ATA they will receive an email containing all information that was previously included in the packet.
