In response to a request from the gasoline distributing industry, ADEM has prepared the following:

September 27, 2024

In anticipation of the potential fuel access issues that may be created by Hurricane Helene, the Alabama Department of Environmental Management will not take enforcement action for the loading of gasoline at Alabama bulk gasoline terminals and/or refineries by tank trucks that do not possess valid ADEM or Jefferson County Air Permits and Air Stickers, if the lack of an air sticker can truly be traced to this emergency.

Tank trucks desiring to load without valid ADEM or Jefferson County Air Permits and Air Stickers must state to terminal personnel that they are requesting to load due to the Hurricane Helene emergency and that there is no alternative to obtain gasoline products to service their respective States and/or clients. The decision to not take enforcement action will apply to all Alabama terminals and/or refineries that allow tank trucks to load without valid ADEM or Jefferson County Air Permits and Air Stickers during this emergency.

ADEM will continue the practice described above until October 11, 2024, unless sooner terminated. The Department will reconsider this deadline if the emergency continues.
